FORMAT OF GROUP/CLASS/DIVISION RACING:

POINTSCORE SYSTEM:

Zero points system (0,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10.....) for all race finishing points.

Non Starters and non-finishers will be awarded a finishing position (after all finishers) based on the number of laps completed, from highest to lowest. In instances of a tie on laps, the Driver with the lower grid position will be awarded the lower points. Total points or each Class/Division from the Heats and Final will determine the overall winners and placegetters.

TROPHIES & PRIZES:

Trophies/awards will be determined by All Points Count

Trophies/awards will be presented to the first 3 places in each Class.

Other prizes and awards may also be presented at the discretion of the Club/Organiser.

CONTROL FUEL:

Control Fuel will be used at this meeting.

4SS Classes may use Caltex 95 Unleaded or Premium 98 Unleaded fuel. All other Classes will use Caltex Vortex Unleaded fuel only.

The Fuel may be purchased up to two days prior to the Meeting. Proof of purchase of the fuel must be retained and produced to the Chief Scrutineer if required.

F. CLUB/TRACK REQUIREMENTS

MEDICAL SERVICES:

RACE TRACK ENTRY:

Once the Race Track gate(s) are closed and Karts start moving, there will be no further entry or exit of Karts, persons or equipment to the Race Track, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Race Track area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

OTHER:

No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.

No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.

Overnight camping Is permitted on the grounds.

Please keep the Ambulance gate/entrance clear at all times.
