FORMAT OF GROUP/CLASS/DIVISION RACING:

Practice	There will be 1 practice session. Each practice session will be 5 Laps duration.	
Qualifying	There will be No Timed Qualifying sessions at this Meeting.	
Race	Laps	Grid Determination
Heat 1	8	Grid will be Random drawn.
Heat 2	8	Grid will be Random drawn.
Heat 3	8	Grid will be Random drawn.
Heat 4	8	Grid will be Random drawn.
Final	12	Lowest points total from all Heats to Grid 1, next lowest total to Grid 2 etc

POINTSCORE SYSTEM:

Zero points system (0,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10.....) for all race finishing points.
Non Starters and non finishers will be awarded a finishing position (after all finishers) based on the number of laps completed, from highest to lowest. In instances of a tie on laps, the Driver with the lower grid position will be awarded the lower points.
Total points for each Class/Division from the Heats and Final will determine the overall winners and placegetters.

TROPHIES & PRIZES:

Trophies/awards will be determined by All Points Count .
Trophies/awards will be presented to the first 3 places in each Class/Division.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
Pit Crew must only enter the Race Track area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

OTHER:

No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
 No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.
 Overnight camping Is permitted on the grounds.
 Please keep the Ambulance gate/entrance clear at all times.
